LITTLE GEM'S PRE-SCHOOL are looking to appoint a new Pre-School Supervisor from September.

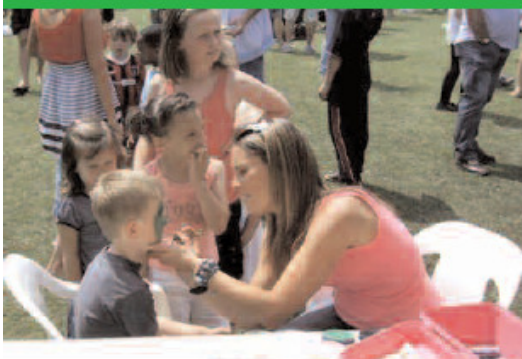
They will be expected to work 20.5 hours per week, term-time only and will be supported by a team of trustees and staff.

On the 18th of April eight of our young men set off on their Silver Duke of Edinburgh expedition. On the 20th of April only 7 returned!

Unfortunately on the second day Jack followed the wrong path, a path that led him on a holiday in Ireland with his grandparents.

Over the three days the lads covered 43 kilometres from Hayfield to Edale to Glossop carrying (on average) 14 kilograms each in their rucksacks including their tents, cookers and food. They also had to navigate their own way using maps and compasses, following bearings across Kinder Scout. Besides the hard work they also found plenty of fun mainly the rope swing over the river which some lads braved to swing and jump across!



As well as this expedition the lads will have to do volunteer work, practice a skill (guitar, cooking, sewing? etc.) and some physical recreation to complete their silver D of E.

- 4  **'Getting to Know You'** - sharing Jesus with Muslims, with integrity - led by John and Janice Brett who have 18 years experience of working in Islamic Africa and are now working with Muslims in Manchester.
