¹⁶ That evening they brought to him many who were oppressed by demons, and he cast out the spirits with a word and healed all who were sick.




Matthew 8:14-17

17 This was to fulfil what was spoken by the prophet Isaiah: "He took our illnesses and bore our diseases."







... You rule over all, and in Your hand is power and might ... (1 Chronicles 29:12)











